Planning your Trip to Shaw Woods Outdoor Education Centre


Here are a few helpful tips to consider when planning your trip to our centre.

- We are a completely outdoor facility. All participants need to be prepared to spend the duration of their visit outside. See list below.
- We have a Pine Pavilion whereby the students can leave their backpacks and enjoy their lunch at our 30foot picnic table.
- We encourage students to leave no trace. We ask that they take their garbage back with them.
- Everyone will have access to our onsite outhouses, but there are no washrooms on the trails.
- If there are forecasts for inclement weather, and you do decide to make the trip, we ask that busses stay in case they are needed.

Planning Your Visit

Please dress seasonally and according to the weather on the day of your visit

SPRING, SUMMER AND AUTUMN

- 🌿 pants and long-sleeved shirts are recommended to help prevent scrapes and insect bites (especially from April-June)
- 🌿 a light jacket
- 🌿 raincoat, rain boots, splash pants
- 🌿 sun block, hat
- 🌿 bug jacket or bug hat &/or insect repellent
- 🌿 closed-toe shoes or hiking boots

WINTER

- 🌿 warm winter boots
- 🌿 a snowsuit
- 🌿 warm hat/toque, scarf, warm mittens
- 🌿 layers of clothes: long underwear, long-sleeved shirt and sweater
- 🌿 extra pair of socks and mittens
- 🌿 sun block

OTHER

- a back pack to hold your lunch and extra clothes
- a healthy peanut-free snack and lunch, water bottle, smile ☺
